

How do I know when I am Shot?

That is a good question since we all know that infra-red light is invisible to the human eye. So what happens when you get shot? Nothing physical happens to you, but the sensors on the gun will detect the light from your opponent's gun (which was fired at you) and it will flash once. At the same time, the gun will let out a loud noise. Also, the screen which displays your remaining number of lives will reduce by 1 (we are assuming that you have more than 1 live when you are shot).

Usually, during game play, players will realise that they are shot from the noise they hear from their guns as they will not have time to check whether their sensors are blinking or look at their screen.
